Item	Reason ?	Estimated Cost
Straw	For barn floor to put a new surface down ready for this winters sessions	£500
New shed	To house the toilet in the barn. The old one is now over 10 years old it came from our old field and has seen better days	£200
Tall hurdles	To make two pens in the barn for the ponies to rest in when not taking part in the session. (And to stop Kira making holes in the wall by leaning on it !!)	£400
A stock of hay	After the very unusual summer the farmers have not been able to produce their normal amount of hay, its price is rising and by spring it is likely to be in very short supply so we want to buy in bulk in the next few weeks to ensure the ponies feed this winter (300 bales)	£1200
Tractor	Our current tractor is a vintage vehicle which is loaned to us and it is not strong enough to do the amount of work we are asking of it. It regularly over heats. We are saving to buy a more up to date machine that will do all the work we require of it to maintain the site and move hay etc. around as we need it	£ 8000 second hand or £16000 new
Horse box	To take horses to the vet if necessary and to transport horses so that we can do more out reach work to schools etc.	£16000
Facilitator time	Employment costs for a facilitator one day a week paid at living wage rate of £8.25 per hour	£3500
Session Equipment	Equipment for the families to use when they attend sessions	£1000
Saddle and bridle for pony	Tom needs a new saddle and bridle so that we can offer riding to some young people where there is a therapeutic value	£600
6 sessions	Six sessions for a family or teenager who could not otherwise use our service.	£360
